



Positions available for 2012

Located in the beautiful woods of Huron National Forest, just outside Oscoda, Michigan. We operate 9 weeks of camp during the summer and parent/child weekends in the spring and the fall.

ALL POSITIONS REQUIRE PEOPLE COMMITTED TO A GROWING RELATIONSHIP WITH JESUS CHRIST AND A STRONG DESIRE TO WORK WITH CHILDREN OF VARIOUS AGE GROUPS.

PROGRAM DIRECTOR: (1)

The program director is responsible for each week's programming. This includes supervising the activity classes and activity staff. Monitoring instructors' needs; material, physical, emotional, and spiritual. As a leader, you play an important role in maintaining positive group dynamics within the staff. It is vital that you have a high level of integrity, and act with love when dealing with campers and other staff members. You are in a position where you will need to give and receive correction gracefully. Summer commitment 4 weeks: June 28-July 28

Compensation: volunteer

BUSINESS MANAGER: (1)

Responsibilities include registration of campers, recording and balancing accounts, mail, phone calls, banking, and town trips. Needs to be familiar with all camp programs and be capable of maintaining full confidentiality and integrity in regards to payroll issues, as well as account issues. Must be proficient in Microsoft Office, especially Excel. Summer commitment 4 weeks: June 28-July 28

Compensation: volunteer

CAMP COUNSELOR: (12)

Live in a tent or cabin with approximately 8 campers, lead daily bible studies, teach an activity class to campers of various ages and participate in all camp activities include divisionals, and campfires. Assist in leading songfest after meals. *This can be a full summer position, but your role may change during non-counseling weeks.*

GIRLS CAMP COMMITMENT 1 week in July, plus 3 days training.

BOYS CAMP COMMITMENT- 1 week in July, plus 3 day training

Compensation: volunteer

DIVISION DIRECTOR: (3)

Responsibilities include the supervision of all counselors in the division and leading a daily meeting with those counselors. Plan and supervise all division activities such as campfires, games, and bible study. Assist counselors with any problems they may have with campers or equipment. Some maintenance abilities required.

GIRLS CAMP COMMITMENT 1 week in July, plus 3 days training.

BOYS CAMP COMMITMENT 1 week in July, plus 3 days training.

Compensation: volunteer

ACTIVITY SPECIALIST: (5)

Responsible for teaching three skills classes and assisting the Program Director with all other programs. Responsible for teaching skills classes each day, planning and preparing activity area. Tracking progress, and teaching a memory verse. May teach different classes each week based on experience and need. Assist program director with all other programs.

Compensation: volunteer

WATER SAFETY INSTRUCTOR: (1)

Responsible for the pool and all water activities. Coordinate lifeguards and pool coverage, teach swimming lessons, and perform pool maintenance including chemical checks, water samples, and cleaning. Participate in other camp activities, campfires, bible studies, etc. Must be certified WSI and Lifeguard.

Compensation: volunteer

HORSEMANSHIP INSTRUCTOR: (1)

Responsible for 8 horses and all stable hands. Feed, water, groom, tack repair. Teach riding lessons and supervise free time riding. Participate in other camp activities including campfires, bible studies, etc. 21 years old and CHA certification or equivalent experience desired.

Summer commitment 4 weeks: June 28-July28

Compensation: volunteer

TRIP LEADERS/COUNSELORS: (4)

To outfit, guide, lead and teach outdoor skills to youth on offsite trips. To share God's beautiful creation with others while in the Huron National Forest. Organize and assess gear and equipment, making necessary repairs. Package the food and equipment for the trips. We need leaders for both our S.O.A.R. and TTC program. S.O.A.R. is a 5-day canoe trip where you will camp at various sites, and canoe over 40 miles of the AuSable River. TTC (Triple Trip Challenge) is a program where you must have the ability to backpack, canoe, and bike as well as cook over an open fire and camp outdoors for 5-days. Lifeguarding, CPR/First Aid, and Wilderness First Aid required. Must be at least (18) years old. One trip leader is required to be 21 years old.

Compensation: volunteer

TEAM ELIJAH COORDINATOR: (1)

Coordinate and counsel a team of 7-8 teens who wash dishes, clean the stables, and do maintenance/work projects around camp. Responsible for leading bible studies, supervising their work, and planning evening activities. You will be living in the tent with the group.

Compensation: volunteer

MAINTENANCE SPECIALIST: (1)

Responsible for site. Mowing, repairs on equipment and vehicle maintenance are just a few of the jobs. Summer commitment desired.

COOKS:

Responsible for food and meal preparation. Compliance with state regulations on safety in food prep, storage, and service. Work with administrative assistant to inventory and order food for each week. Awareness of camper allergy and dietary needs as necessary. Help promote a positive camp experience.
